The EFL is now looking to appoint a Non-Executive Director to the Board, to replace the incumbent whose term expires. The Board of Directors comprises of 3 Directors from The Championship, 2 Directors from League 1 and 1 Director from League 2, each elected by the 24 clubs in their respective Divisions. The remaining Directors are the EFL Chief Executive Officer, 2 Independent Non-Executive Directors and a Non-Executive Chairman.

The Chief Executive Officer is responsible for the Executive functions of the EFL including the Operations Centre in Preston and Commercial Centre in London.

The successful candidate will be required to spend a minimum of 24 days per annum on work for the EFL, including Board Meetings, the AGM (which includes the Owners and Executives Conference held over the two preceding days) an annual Board away day and at least three all club meetings per year.

This commitment will increase where the successful candidate is appointed to sub-committees of the Board and / or the EFL is undergoing a period of particular increased activity.
