Role Purpose: The post holder will be responsible for delivering a range of football and sport-based programmes within a school and/or Community setting.

- Support teachers to increase their knowledge, confidence and skills in delivering high quality physical education lessons.
- Develop and maintain relationships with key stakeholders and customers to execute a successful School Sport offer.
- To take responsibility for your own performance, training and continuous professional development (including attending relevant planning meetings and CPD opportunities)
- To carry out risk assessments and report any incidents / accidents to the line manager immediately.
