The purpose of the role is:

Responsible for the physiotherapy cover of Academy players in training and games programme

Main Duties and Responsibilities:

- Oversee all injury-related matters for Academy players
- Liaise with the Academy doctor, Head Academy Physio, Academy Manager, coaches and medical staff concerning injury matters of the Academy players
- Coordinate physiotherapy cover for all Academy games
- Maintain all first aid equipment ensuring that it is in-date, accessible and transported to all venues
- Ensure there is sufficient first aid equipment for multiple patients
- Attend training and games as requested – prior, during and after the game/session
- Maintain up-to-date and secure records for all player injuries and treatments
- Provide verbal handover for injured players to the appropriate medical staff
- Comply fully with the FA doping control policy, and ensure all Academy players are aware of the procedures
- Report to the Head Academy Physiotherapist and 1st Team Physiotherapist as and when necessary
- Deliver medical/health education training to Academy players and staff
- Work professionally and clinically within H&S guidelines
- Ensure performance of all Academy players is optimised through effective, timely and appropriate intervention
- Maintain high standards of clinical and professional work in accordance with CSP guidelines

- Chartered Physiotherapist – HCPC registered

- Experience of working with young elite athletes and creating/managing programmes to facilitate their long term athletic development.
