### Accountabilities/Responsibilities

#### Academy Coaching / Games Programme:

- Work closely with the Lead Performance Analyst capture appropriate footage from games & training for individual player development.
- Through own delivery & coordination of match analysis bank staff ensure filming of all home Academy games (U9-U16) throughout the season.
- Work with the Head of Schoolboy Coaching to provide coded match footage for schoolboy programme.
- Support the Lead Performance Analyst with footage/data management, including the management and organisation of the Hudl platform.

#### Staff

- Work closely with the Lead Performance Analyst to capture appropriate footage from games & training for coach development.

#### Women's Senior Team:

- Through own delivery & coordination of match analysis bank staff ensure the filming of all WFC games throughout the season, as well as selected training sessions.
- Work with WFC Head Coach and Coaching team to provide relevant coded footage for individual and team development.
- Work with WFC Head Coach to provide relevant coded footage for opposition / individual match analysis.
