## Tunnel Doctor

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### Job Summary:

To be the emergency care Doctor on a matchday for First Team Players and relevant match officials.

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### Roles and Responsibilities:

- Oversee the pitch side emergency care, working closely with the Paramedics, Stretcher Bearers and Medical Team.
- Run regular training sessions and injury scenarios.
- Liaise with the Away Team Doctor prior to each Match to inform them of Burnley FC's emergency care protocols, familiarise them with the medical facilities, meet the Paramedics and deal with any queries.
- Contact the local hospital emergency departments and their consultants to update emergency care protocols.
- Act as the lead point of co-ordination for all Players or Match Officials referred to hospital, oversee their transfer, liaise regarding their in-hospital care and subsequent discharge.
- At the request of the Club Doctor, you will assist with the treatment of injuries and/or care for and monitor any Player or Match Official who has left the field of play.
- Work closely with the Club Doctor, the First Team Physiotherapist and the wider medical team.
- Responsible for ensuring match day emergency action plans are up to date and disseminated.
- Ensure all Stadium emergency equipment is present and in good working order.

- Comply with all Club policies.
- To work towards agreed objectives.
- Always demonstrate the Club's values.
- To be able to work flexible hours where the role of the job requires.
