An exciting opportunity has arisen here at Sheffield United Academy for enthusiastic and committed physiotherapists/sports therapists to join our medical team on a casual basis. Successful candidates should be self-motivated and driven by both personal development and that of the players in our Academy system.

Role Responsibilities:

- Providing home and away pitch-side medical cover at Sunday fixtures across pre-Academy, Foundation and Youth phase age groups (U9 – U16), covering at least 2 matches per month.
- To utilise PMA to generate injury reports, individual WRP, SOAP notes and general medical notes including clinical assessment and RTP pathway.
- Covering the evening clinic and Saturday matches, and covering Foundation and Youth Phase tournaments where required.
- Liaising with the medical staff and wider Elite Performance team in the treatment and management of injured players.
- To partake in the weekly Continued Professional Development (CPD) of Sports Physiotherapy Programme, including compulsory pitch-side/trauma teaching session.

This role places a strong emphasis on the ability to cover the pitch-side of our Sunday matches and this will be the priority within the role.

Essential Criteria for the role:

- Member of the Chartered Society of Physiotherapy/Society of Sports Therapists.
- Member of the HCPC/SST.
- Experience in working in a musculoskeletal setting.
- To hold a criminal record check through the Disclosure and Barring Service.

Desirable Criteria for the role:

- Prior experience of working pitch-side and pitch-side qualification (ITMMiF or equivalent).
- Previous experience with the Premier League PMA.
- Full UK driving licence with access to a vehicle.
